Irina Rozanova is laureate of the International Festival-Contest, (Bulgaria, 2008, third prize), and also of the Fifth International Contest (Russia, 2008) in the Chamber Ensemble category. She is the holder of a Diploma of the International Contest Marcello Galanti in Rimini, (Italy, 2009), and laureate of the International Contest 'Organo Duo' (Russia, 2011, second prize).

Irina regularly gives concerts as a soloist and in various ensembles in Russia: St. Petersburg, Moscow, Krasnoyarsk, Saratov, Petrozavodsk, Sochi and abroad: Finland, Netherlands (Martini Kerk), UK (Westminster Cathedral) and Malta.

Her repertoire includes music of different styles and eras, of both Russian and foreign composers. She gives concerts with leading orchestral and choral ensembles.

In 2011, Irina recorded two CDs of music by Marcel Dupré, with Ilya Ioffe (violin) and Konstantin Kucherov (cello), and Luigi Boccherini's *Stabat Mater* with Hope Drobysheuskaya (soprano).

She teaches organ in the Boys Choir School of Glinka. She is also involved in the organisation of the organ annual festival in St. Petersburg.
