Erland Hildén has been employed since 1998 as organist and choir master in Örgryte parish Gothenburg. Before this Erland worked from 1991 as assistant organist at Karlstad Cathedral, Sweden.

Erland has studied in Arvika (university exam as music teacher), Stockholm (university exam as church musician), Gothenburg (university exam as choir pedagogue), and Piteå (university exam Master as Concert organist).

Erland's main teacher was Professor Hans-Ola Ericsson. He has also taken part in masterclasses with teachers such as Harald Vogel, Hans Fagius, Kevin Bowyer, Jon Laukvik and Bernard Haas.

Erland gives organ recitals on a regular basis around Sweden and in several European countries. He has performed on both Swedish radio and television. He has recorded three solo CDs, and every year he also conducts major choral works such as Bach's *St. John Passion*, Brahms's *Requiem*, Mozart's *Requiem* etc. As a composer he has written more than 50 opus, and Doblinger (Austria) is his main publisher.
