

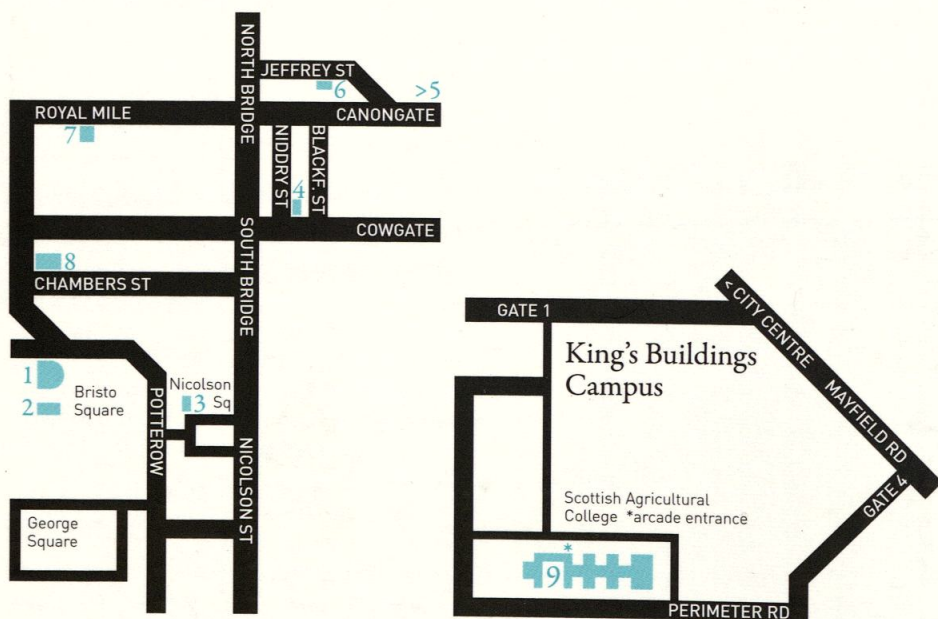

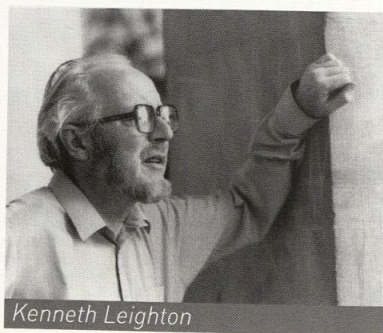

**KENNETH LEIGHTON** (1929-1988) was one of the most distinguished of British post-war composers; over 100 compositions are published, many of which were written to commission, and his work is frequently performed and broadcast both in Britain and abroad. In October 1970 he was appointed Reid Professor of Music at the University of Edinburgh, the post which he held until his death in 1988. This concert, featuring two of Leighton's works for solo piano, marks his eightieth birthday year.
