UNIVERSITY ORCHESTRAL and CHAMBER CONCERTS.

You very kindly honoured us by a request for a number of complimentary tickets for the use of yourself and members of your family for the Concerts being held this season.

You would I am sure understand that, with the limited seating capacity of the Reid School of Music, the number of complimentary tickets issued inevitably limits the number of seats remaining available for sale to members of the public and for admission of University students who are admitted free of charge. In the first few Concerts of the season, we have found that only about one third to one half of the complimentary tickets issued to members of staff on request have, in fact, been used. May I express the hope that you will find it possible to use the tickets for which you have asked.

To ensure securing a seat, it would be advisable to be present not later than 10 minutes before the opening of any Concert.

USHER HALL, Tuesday, 4th December. I would especially ask that the tickets issued for the Concert in the Usher Hall on Tuesday, 4th December, should be used - otherwise there will be good seats remaining empty in the hall from which the public will have been excluded. Should you, therefore, not be able to use your tickets for that Concert, might I ask you to return them not later than Monday, 3rd December.
